

2024 PV Circularity Workshop – Poster Guidelines

Guidance on Presentation Content

Whether you are giving an oral presentation or a poster presentation, please keep your presentation content nonproprietary, as it will be included in the 2024 PV Circularity Workshop Proceedings. You will be asked to verify that your presentation is nonproprietary when you register for the 2024 PV Circularity Workshop.

Poster Dimensions

The maximum dimensions for displayed posters are 46 inches wide by 48 inches long. You may be able to customize your poster print for these dimensions. Common paper sizes that would fit inside the maximum dimensions include:

- ANSI Standard Paper Size E (34 inches wide by 44 inches long)
- Architectural Size Arch E (also known as Arch 6: 36 inches wide by 48 inches long)
- ISO Paper Size A0 (approximately 33.1 inches wide by 46.8 inches long)

Most attendees will travel to the workshop with their posters. The closest large-format printer to the workshop is 3.3 miles from the hotel.

Hanging Your Poster

If your travel plans allow, please hang your poster before the first poster session on Sunday or Monday. Many people like to browse the posters during off hours.

In the workshop program, each poster is assigned a number. Find your number on the poster boards in the City Lights room to the left of the check-in desk and hang your poster there. Thumbtacks are provided.

Presenting Your Poster

To generate further networking and relationship building, poster presenters will get 3 minutes to present their research or ideas to all the attendees during the **lightning round** on Monday before the poster session starts.

During the poster session (one hour total) stand by your poster, or have a co-author do so, to present the information and answer questions. Only posters with presenters stationed at them during the assigned time will be considered for poster awards.

Removing Your Poster

If possible, please leave your poster hanging through the end of Tuesday. Many people like to browse the posters during off hours. If you would like to take your poster home, please retrieve it by 5:00 p.m. on March 6 or it will be discarded.
